Description

PRINCE2 Agile® is probably the most appropriate project management approach, combining the strengths of the governance and controls of PRINCE2® with the flexibility and responsiveness of an agile context. PRINCE2® focuses more on directing and managing projects, while Agility focuses more on product delivery. Combining the three project's areas, all main aspects of a project are now addressed. This course is designed to demonstrate to attendees how PRINCE2® and Agile are working together and how they interact using an approach tailored to suits your projects' environment.

- Frequent releases, review, retrospective
